Example 1 $\frac{8}{10} + \frac{4}{5} = \frac{8}{10} + \frac{8}{10} = \frac{16}{10} = \frac{8}{5} = 1 \frac{3}{5}$

Example 2 $\frac{1}{4} + \frac{5}{10} = \frac{5}{20} + \frac{10}{20} = \frac{15}{20} = \frac{3}{4}$
